# The Mobile Response Teams – Onsite Crisis Support Available 24 hours / 7 days a week

Mobile Response Teams (MRTs) are intended to provide on-demand crisis intervention and de-escalation in any setting in which a behavioral health crisis occurs. The primary goals of Mobile Response Teams are to lessen trauma; conduct an independent assessment to determine if the individual may be safely diverted from emergency departments; prevent unnecessary psychiatric hospitalization; or divert from juvenile justice or criminal justice settings. Mobile Response Teams work with individuals and families to identify resources, provide linkages, and develop strategies for effectively dealing with potential future crises.

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### **Crisis Stabilization Units (CSUs)**

Crisis Stabilization Units (CSUs) provide emergency psychiatric support for children and adults, typically under the Florida Mental Health Act, commonly known as the Baker Act. Crisis Stabilization Units help to keep people safe who are at imminent risk of harm, either for themselves or others.


